## RIGHT OF THE NHIS ENROLLEE

EVERY PERSON REGISTERED TO ACCESS HEALTH CARE UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE SCHEME (NHIS) IS ENTITLED TO THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

- Right of Access to Medical Treatment as Outlined in the NHIS Benefit Package.
- Right to select a Healthcare Facility of choice as long as the Facility is Accredited by the Scheme.
- Right to change a Primary Healthcare Facility after six (6) Months of access, if not satisfied with the services provided.
- Right to change facility once it has closed, relocated, or delisted by the NHIS.
- Right to change facility once you have been transferred to another location.
- Right to choose an alternative Facility for Dependants if they are living in a different location.
- Right to access Healthcare at any NHIS accredited facility in an emergency.
- Right to complain to NHIS or HMOs about any act of negligence on the part of the Healthcare Facility.
- $\checkmark$  Right to be referred for secondary and tertiary healthcare.
